The Biomedical Sciences Program (BSP) is the premier umbrella graduate program at CU Anschutz. BSP is an interdisciplinary and interdepartmental program designed to provide incoming students with the greatest amount of flexibility in choosing a course of study. As members of the program, our students have access to over 130 highly accomplished training faculty in 11 different PhD graduate programs.

CAREER PATHS OF GRADUATES

Although students enter a specific area of concentration at the end of their first year, they are still a part of the BSP family. Our graduates pursue government, biotechnology, and academic postdoctoral work at institutions such as Harvard, UNC, Duke, UCSD, UCSF, and Stanford.

We provide students a world-class graduate training experience in an interactive and interdisciplinary environment that allows for an individualized learning experience. We accomplish this by training students to evaluate scientific literature, think critically, and develop testable hypotheses, while providing mentorship throughout the process.
